- Age limit Teens and up

# **HOSPITALITY:** RiverStone Church – a team providing assistance at the August 19<sup>th</sup> picnic.

- Projects: setup, grilling, breakdown and cleanup.
- 10 volunteers needed
- Age limit Teens and up

## MUST MINISTRIES: Marietta, GA – a faith-based, charitable organization providing services to individuals while maintaining their dignity.

- Projects: deck construction, interior painting, sorting clothes, stocking food, and assembling sack lunches (offsite).
- 65 volunteers needed (including experienced carpenters)
- Age limit varies by project

# PARK STREET ELEMENTARY: Marietta, GA – a local school in partnership with Stonebridge.

- Projects: outdoor landscaping and hosting a back to school bash (cookout, games) for nearby residents.
- 20 volunteers needed
- No age limit

## PAULDING PREGNANCY: Dallas, GA – a non-profit organization offering support to those facing unexpected pregnancies.

- Projects: interior painting and carpet cleaning.
- 10 volunteers needed
- Age limit Teens and up

# THE EXTENSION: Marietta, GA – a residential treatment program for homeless men and women struggling with addictions.

- Projects: building a structure to screen trash cans (at Women's Campus) and assembling sack lunches (offsite).
